

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bid proposals on forms prepared by Wilson & Company, Inc., Engineers & Architects (hereinafter called “Consultant” and “Project Manager”) will be received by the Taos Pueblo, (hereinafter called “Pueblo” and “Owner”), at the **Wilson & Company Office, 4401 Masthead St, NE, Suite 150, Albuquerque, NM 87109**, until **10:00 am** (local time) on **December 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022** and will be publicly opened and read aloud immediately thereafter: the Rio Lucero Road Grade, Drain, and Hot Asphalt Concrete Paving Project. The project is located in Taos County, New Mexico. The Project consists of roadway improvements, grading, drainage, and hot asphalt concrete pavement. The following conditions apply to prospective bidders:
